## EVERYDAY GUIDELINES

### INFORMATIONS

Shoes	must have backs
Hair	clean, dry and trim. No longer than the bottom of the collar and covering no more than the middle of the ear. Conservative in style (mohawks/fohawks are e.g. of not conservative). No outlandish colors. Administration has full discretion.
Facial Hair	sideburns should not be extra wide or longer than the bottom of the ear. Must be clean shaven
Jewelry	one small necklace, bracelet. No earrings.
Clothing	should be clean, neat and in proper repair
Jackets/Hoodies	should not be worn in the classroom
Accessories	laser lights, lighters, knives, chains etc. are unacceptable
Tattoos	no visible tattoos
Ties	optional

### INFORMATIONS

# DRESS CODE POLICY

## DRESS CODE PHILOSOPHY

CCS utilizes a standardized dress code for the following reasons:

- Eliminates clothing competition
- Removes the “fashion” element from the scholastic environment
- Promotes discipline and uniformity in the student body

The dress code will be enforced from the time a student arrives on campus until the student is dismissed. All “appearance elements” (major articles of clothing, accessories, jewelry, hair etc.) should be conservative in nature. The administration reserves the right to initiate policies relative to fads or changes in style throughout the school year. The dress code is in effect at any school sponsored event. Parents bear the burden of ultimate responsibility in maintaining dress code compliance. Parents/students who perpetually compromise the dress and uniform code policy will be subject to dismissal
