

## TUITION & FEES

### 2025 – 2026

#### Curriculum Fee:

**All Students: \$300\***

All Curriculum Fees must be paid by June 1. Failure to pay or to make payment arrangements with the CCS Business Office will result in the student's seat being vacated. The Curriculum Fee is utilized for the purchase of new books, rental of books, and all things related to curriculum. Families receiving the Parent Choice Tax Credit will still be required to pay the Curriculum Fee by June 1.

#### Enrollment Fee:

**All Students: \$1200\***

All Enrollment Fees must be paid by July 1. Failure to pay or to make payment arrangements with the CCS Business Office will result in the student's seat being vacated. Please see the following page for a breakdown of the Enrollment Fee. Families receiving the Parent Choice Tax Credit will be required to pay the first \$300 of the Enrollment Fee by July 1. (the remainder of the enrollment fee must be paid within a week of receiving your PCTC check).

#### Tuition:

**1<sup>st</sup> Student:** \$5384/year or \$538.40/month

**2<sup>nd</sup> Student:** \$5009/year or \$500.90/month

**3<sup>rd</sup> Student +:** \$4652/year or \$465.20/month

Monthly payments are due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month (August-May). \* A late fee of \$25 will be assessed for unpaid accounts after the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month.\*

## EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES FEES

Students participating in extra-curricular activities may incur additional sports or club related fees. These fees help with the cost of equipment, uniforms, transportation, tournament/meet entry fees, and more.
